## OUTDOOR SERVICE: 10:00am

We are excited to be meeting in person, but need everyone's help to make these services go smoothly. Please help us by keeping the following in mind. Also, read below for the details on what to do before, during and after an outdoor service.



### Help us remain mindful of capacity limits

Our team will be monitoring how many people are arriving at CCC. If we reach a point where we can't accommodate everyone with social distancing, we will be closing the entrances to the church.

If you arrive and the entrances are closed, plan to watch our online service.



### Stay up to date with the latest information

We are doing our best to stay ahead of rapidly changing developments during this season. Before you come to church, please check [visitccc.com](http://visitccc.com) to get the latest update on our outdoor services.

We will be monitoring the weather (and the daily news cycle) and will have an update on whether or not our in-person services will be held each week. *This update will be posted no later than 6:00am every Sunday.*

## Collectively let's Be Wise, Be Safe, Be TOGETHER

### BEFORE YOU ARRIVE, BE WISE



#### Determine if you are in a high-risk group.

If you have underlying health conditions or are at high risk, we encourage you to continue worshipping with us online. *If you or anyone in your household are sick or feeling sick, do not attend in-person.*



#### Bring what you need to sit.

Bring an outdoor chair or blanket for you and/or your family. Shade umbrellas or personal pop-up tents for shade are allowed. We will have limited tent space for those who require shelter.



#### Bring a mask and hand sanitizer.

Everyone is now required to wear a mask while at church. Hand sanitizer stations will be provided for you if you do not have your own.



#### Bring a Bible, pen and bottled water.

For safety reasons we will not be providing printed material, handouts, food or allowing access to shared water fountains. Please bring a Bible (or use the Bible App on your phone), bottled water to drink and any food or supplies you need.

### WHILE ON SITE, BE SAFE



#### Everyone must wear a mask

As a courtesy to others, and in compliance with the recent PA order to require masks in public spaces, *wearing a mask while on campus will be mandatory.*



#### Practice social distancing

We know you want to greet people, but please avoid handshakes and hugs and *maintain a 6-foot distance from others (outside your family).* Be sure to wave and smile with your eyes!



#### Please help us limit facility access

We will be opening a single entrance (the playground entrance) to allow emergency access to the indoor bathrooms, but we ask that you help us limit use of these bathrooms if possible.



#### Parents, be sure to stay with your kids!

Childcare / kids programs will not be provided at the outdoor services. Parents must stay with and monitor their children at all times for their safety and the safety of those around you. *We ask that parents keep their children from using the playground,* which will not be monitored or sanitized.

### Why aren't we meeting inside now?

Our leadership team continues in daily conversation about the wisest course of action. At this time, due to required restrictions on large-group gatherings (even during the green phase), the quality of any indoor service we would be able to offer would be poor. We will continue to monitor the situation daily and look forward to further re-opening as soon as it is possible to do so well.

### What about other CCC events?

Each ministry is evaluating how and when they can begin to meet in person. Many have already started to meet outdoors as they are able (such as Sunday 6:30pm prayer on the front lawn). Please contact the ministry directors if you have specific questions, and look for our weekly emails which will contain the most up-to-date information on CCC events offered.
