- Connection Time- The first 10-15 minutes each week is offered for coffee/tea and connecting with others. Some weeks will include a time of worship and encouragement.
- **Group Time** Time in smaller groups allows for personal discussion of the study, along with accountability and support as we seek the truth of God's Word. Groups are approximately 12-17 women including leaders. Groups remain together throughout the WBS year.
- Community Service We serve our community throughout the WBS year.

Registration

Bible study cost is \$50 or \$60 for the year depending on which study track you choose. Study tracks 1 & 3 are \$50 and Track 2 is \$60. Payment can be made online (credit card) or at the Ministry Center on some Sundays (cash or check payable to Christ Community Church). **Early cost ends August 31st, 2024. Cost will increase by \$5 after this date.**

WBS Kidz

WBS Kidz is an integrated part of our Women's Ministry offered on Thursday mornings. We provide a biblically based morning of fun, friendship and love for infants through Kindergarten. A Homeschool Team room is offered for kids in grades 1st-5th.

This is a place of belonging as our volunteers are committed to their classes for the entire year and truly build meaningful relationships with both kids and moms. We are blessed to have such an amazing team!

A minimum of \$10 per child is required to secure your spot. This fee is non-refundable and will be counted towards the overall cost of \$50 per child.

Track 1 (Cost ~ \$50) Offered on campus & virtually on Zoom

Luke by N.T. Wright (10 weeks Book study guide, weekly at home study, & group discussions)

N.T. Wright invites you to explore the New Testament book of Luke where the life of Jesus is described in the heart of the first-century Jewish and Roman culture when the Christian gospel began to spread far and wide. Luke provides an eye witness, historical account of the life of Jesus and shares how His words, actions and experiences changed the course of history.

Gospel on the Ground - The Grit & Glory of the Early Church in Acts by Kristi McLelland

(14 weeks ~ Book study guide, weekly at home study, alternating weeks of videos & group discussions)

Join Kristi McLelland as she teaches how Jesus' message of hope and reconciliation spread from Jerusalem to the far corners of the earth. This study follows the early years of the church as told in the New Testament book of Acts. You'll learn that God's kingdom is always on the move, and you'll come to understand what your part is in God's redemptive story.

Track 2 (Cost \$60) Offered on campus only.

<u>Conversation Peace: The Power of Transformed Speech by Mary A. Kassian</u> (6 weeks ~ Book study guide, weekly at home study, & group discussions) Discover the power of transformational speech in this interactive Bible study as you learn the power of navigation, cause and effect, how to accept responsibility for your speech and how to remain teachable.

Grace in Chaos ~ Biblical Hope for the Hard Days of Motherhood (5 weeks ~ Book study guide, weekly at home study & group discussions)

Motherhood can be both the greatest responsibility and the most difficult one. Grace in Chaos will strengthen you with a biblical, gospel-centered vision of motherhood and equip you in truth when you experience difficult situations and emotions. This is for mothers of all ages.

Life Under the Sun by Hannah Anderson (8 weeks ~ Book study guide, weekly at home study & group discussions)

Consider the wisdom of Ecclesiastes as you search for balance in such a disorienting world. Learn to name your concerns and disappointments, and see that this Old Testament book is more than a book of good advice. This study will help you ask the questions that Jesus will eventually answer, as He is the hope for life under the sun.

The Ruthless Elimination of Hurry: How to Stay Emotionally Healthy and Spiritually Alive in the Chaos of the Modern World by John Mark Comer (5 weeks ~book, weekly at home questions, group discussions, brief videos)

John Mark Comer addresses one of the greatest threats to our spiritual lives: hurry. Instead of allowing outside influences to completely control your schedules, consider how Jesus offers you a new rhythm, overflowing with grace, peace, and a slower, simpler pace of life.

Track 3 (Cost \$50) ~ Finding Your Way Bible Study by Kim Burch (September 2024-April 2025~ Book study guide, Bible & group discussions)

In Finding Your Way, you'll spend the year building a framework for understanding the God's Word. As you trace a key theme through the Bible, you will grasp the flow of its storyline. Gathering pieces of the puzzle, you'll begin in the first chapter of the Bible and end in the last chapter, stopping at fifty of the most essential passages along the way. You will create a visual tool by filling in a timeline as you study, examining each piece of the puzzle as you put it in place. And when you have completed Finding Your Way you'll have the big picture – the lid to the puzzle box - and will be prepared for a lifetime of filling in the details as you continue to study the Bible on your own.
