2. Read Ezekiel 1:15-21. God is omnipresent, omniscient, and omnipotent. In your own words, how would you define each of these qualities?

3. Read Ezekiel 2:3-7 and 1st Peter 1:12. God wants us to trust Him. How is God reassuring Ezekiel with His words?

4. Read Read Ezekiel 2:8-3:3a, Hebrews 11:1 and 2 Corinthians 5:7. Sight is not the sense which leads us to faith. What is? And why is that?

5. Read Ezekiel 3:4-9. God has made us for the task that lays ahead of us. How have you been equipped for what lays ahead of you in your life?

God Takes You To The Place You Need To Be

6. Read Ezekiel 3:10-15. God has called you to exactly where you need to be in your home, community, job, etc. God is always interested in your relationship with Him and wants to help you grow and grow your community. What community has God placed you in that you can help share Christ to?

God Gives You A Title

7. Read Ezekiel 3:16-17. What title was given to Ezekiel and how does it compare to titles you have been given?

What are some titles you think God would give you for this season in your life?

8. Read Ezekiel 3:22-23. God reminds you who He is. God likes to invite you to places to remind you of who He is, perhaps a valley, or a lake or a river. Where can you go this week to connect with God and be reminded of who He is?
